Adult High School Diploma

Classes use individualized instruction to help students achieve their Adult High School Diploma. The teacher counsels each student to develop a plan and students then work independently with teacher assistance.

Upon graduation, students may choose to have a short ceremony that includes diploma presentation, cap, gown a personal tassel and pictures.

Tuesdays ~ 2-8 p.m., Wednesdays & Thursdays ~ 10 a.m. - 1 p.m.

You may start the classes at any time and attend when the teacher is available. For example, it is not necessary to attend from 2-8 pm on Tuesday; you may come at any time and leave at any time, depending on your schedule. Before registering for the HiSET test, please create an account and password online at hiset.ets.org. To register, come to the Adult School office with your account number, password and payment (\$140/entire test or \$30/each section). Please be prepared to show your photo ID card (driver's license, state-issued ID card, passport, military ID or Matricula Consular) and to pay for the test with cash, debit/credit card or cashier's check. ***Preparation classes for the GED OR HiSET test** are held here at the Adult School. An assessment test is given at one's first meeting and classes are individualized to meet student's needs. Students attend class when they are able and work independently with teacher assistance until they are confident of passing the test. Test vouchers are available for students attending the GED and HiSET preparation classes (certain restrictions apply).
