SLOHS Tiny Tigers

Dear Co-op Preschool Families,

Families of our 4 year old co-op preschool students who desire longer care may wish to apply to Tiny Tigers Preschool program at San Luis Obispo High School. For families who are accepted, a Parent Participation teacher will supervise a lunch/rest period so students can go directly to the afternoon session of Tiny Tigers.

**THE DETAILS**

Our Parent Participation Preschool and SLOHS Tiny Tigers are distinct programs with separate enrollment procedures, and separate fees. To apply, please contact the Tiny Tigers teacher, Kristi Burleson, at [kburluson@slcusd.org](mailto:kburluson@slcusd.org). By enrolling in both programs, your child will have supervised preschool care Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday until 2:45pm. This is what your child’s day would look like:

Parent Participation Co-op Preschool for 4 year olds at SLOHS	9:15 am -12:15 pm
Lunch Bunch, supervised by a PP Co-op Teacher	12:15-12:50 pm
SLOHS Tiny Tigers Preschool Program	12:50-2:45 pm

**Lunch Bunch:** PPP Students from the 4 year old San Luis Obispo classes who enroll in Tiny Tigers will be supervised by a PPP teacher on the SLOHS preschool playground while they eat lunch, and then the children will continue in the classroom to begin their Tiny Tigers afternoon preschool session.

**Tiny Tigers Preschool:** 12:50 -2:45 pm Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday at the SLO High Preschool Room

There is NO additional cost for PPP students to enroll in the Lunch Bunch. **Only students who are attending the Tiny Tigers preschool are eligible to stay for lunch.** There’s no obligation to enroll in the Tiny Tigers program, but if you’re interested, please register for Tiny Tigers soon.

**ABOUT TINY TIGERS**

*The Tiny Tigers Program through San Luis Obispo High School offers an on the job training opportunity for high school students who are interested in careers that involve children. The high school students are the teachers and run the preschool with a revolving job schedule under the supervision of a credentialed teacher. Tiny Tigers has a long history of providing high-quality, developmentally appropriate early childhood education. The preschool children benefit from play-based learning activities designed to foster growth in the developmental areas of social, emotional, intellectual, moral, and physical development. The Tiny Tigers program is located on the SLOHS campus in their preschool classroom and playground.
